How We Use Your Personal Data

Dean & Wood takes your privacy very seriously and will never disclose, share or sell your data without your consent; unless required to do so by law. We only retain your data for as long as is necessary and for the purposes specified in this notice. Where you have consented to us providing you with promotional offers and marketing, you are free to withdraw this consent at any time. The purposes and reasons for processing your personal data are detailed below: -

Such information will be non-intrusive and is processed on the grounds of legitimate interests (for example, special offers, product information, company updates, etc). You have the right to be removed from the mailing list at any time – please email your request to gdpr@beijerref.co.uk.

Your Rights

You have the right to access any personal information that Dean & Wood processes about you and to request information about: -

- If we did not collect the data directly from you, information about the source

If you believe that we hold any incomplete or inaccurate data about you, you have the right to ask us to correct and/or complete the information and we will strive to update/correct it as quickly as possible; unless there is a valid reason for not doing so, at which point you will be notified.

Transfers Outside the EU

Dean & Wood utilise some products or services (or parts of them) that may be hosted/stored in the USA and Australia, which means that we may transfer any information which is submitted by you through the website outside the European Economic Area ("EEA") for the below purposes: -

- Website hosting
- Email servers
- Marketing database

Therefore, when you use our website/send us an email/sign up to our newsletter etc., the personal information you submit may be stored on servers which are hosted in the USA and Australia. Where this is the case, we will take steps to ensure that those providers use the necessary level of protection for your information and abide by strict agreements and measures set out by Dean & Wood to protect your data and comply with the relevant data protection laws.

Consequences of Not Providing Your Data

You are not obligated to provide your personal information to Dean & Wood, however, as this information is required for us to provide you with our services/deliver your products/legitimate interests, we will not be able to offer some/all of our products or services without it.

Legitimate Interests

We occasionally process your personal information under the legitimate interests' legal basis. Where this is the case, we ensure that we have weighed your interests and any risk posed to you against our own and that such interests are proportionate and appropriate.

How Long We Keep Your Data

Dean & Wood only ever retains personal information for as long as is necessary and we have strict review and retention policies in place to meet these obligations. We are required under UK tax law to keep your basic personal data (name, address, contact details) for a minimum of 7 years after which time it will be destroyed.

All other information will be retained for a period of 7 years from end of contract or date of processing, excluding agency staff and health and safety information which will be retained for 3 years and CCTV images which will be retained for 30 days.

Where you have consented to us using your details for direct marketing, we will keep such data until you notify us otherwise and / or withdraw your consent.

Special Categories Data

Owing to the services that we offer, Dean & Wood sometimes needs to process sensitive personal information (known as special category data) from you, to arrange travel or insurance. Where we collect such information, we will only request and process the minimum necessary for the specified purpose and identify a compliant legal basis for doing so. Where we rely on your consent for processing special category data, we will obtain your explicit consent through a signature/explicit mechanism. You can modify or withdraw consent at any time, which we will act on immediately, unless there is a legitimate or legal reason for not doing so.

CCTV

We have installed CCTV systems in our premises which are used by members of the public, for the purposes of public and staff safety and crime prevention and detection.

Images captured by CCTV will be kept for no longer than is necessary. However, on occasions there may be a need to keep images for longer, for example where a crime is being investigated.

You have the right to see CCTV images of yourself and be provided with a copy of the images.

We will only disclose images to other authorised bodies who intend to use it for the purposes stated above. Images will not be released to the media or placed on the internet for public viewing.

We operate CCTV and disclose in accordance with the codes of practice issued by the Information Commissioners Office (ICO).

Lodging a Complaint

Dean & Wood only processes your personal information in compliance with this privacy notice and in accordance with the relevant data protection laws. If, however you wish to raise a complaint regarding the processing of your personal data or are unsatisfied with how we have handled your information, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.
